**Resolution No. 2023-11**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING SPONSORSHIP OF THE YOUNG AMERICANS CENTER FOR FINANCIAL EDUCATION AS PART OF THE 2024 BUDGET FOR THE ALAMEDA CORRIDOR BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Directors of the Alameda Corridor Business Improvement District (ACBID), Jefferson County, Colorado as follows:

**Section 1.** The Young Americans Center for Financial Education (Young Americans) provides important educational services to elementary school children within the District and surrounding areas. The program is designed to teach 10- and 11-year olds about money management, free enterprise, economics and workforce readiness in a fun and hands-on way.

**Section 2.** The Board of Directors finds that ACBID sponsorship of Young Americans serves the public purposes of improving education for youth in the District, building awareness of business social responsibility and developing business and community leaders for the future. The Partnership Renewal Proposal from Young Americans is attached to this resolution and incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 3.** ACBID sponsorship of Young Americans serves to promote the health, safety, prosperity, security and general welfare of the inhabitants of the District and all the people of the City of Lakewood, Colorado.

**Section 4.** Additionally, sponsorship of Young Americans furthers the marketing and outreach goals of the ACBID by building public awareness and appreciation for the ACBID brand.

**Section 5.** The Board of Directors for the Alameda Corridor Business Improvement District hereby approves the sponsorship of the Young Americans Center for Financial Education in the amount of \$10,000 for budget year 2024.

**Section 6.** This resolution was amended to require that funds for this sponsorship must be spent on programs within the City of Lakewood.
